A memorial to Thomas Sullivan, husband of Virginia Sullivan, is also nearby. Graves of Blanche Johnson, their mother's sister, ,and her son, Susie's cousin, Robert E. Johnson, are in another area at Ivy Hill.

Do not take the next two right turns

- . Go down the hill and then turn right
- . Turn left on Moncastle Lane (Section T)
- . Go about 20 feet and park at the obelisk to Veaton
- . Facing the obelisk from the road, go right and downhill at about 30 degrees toward the large yew bush and holly tree.
- . The Bruch and Sullivan memorials are under these plants.

Susie's ashes are in an unmarked lot at Fort Lincoln Cemetery in Maryland.
Dick's remains will also be sent there.

Susie's memorial is in the same area as those of her parents, aunt, and maternal grandparents in plots T241-242. Her cousin, Robert Erle Johnson, and his mother, Blanche Johnson, are also in Ivy Hill. Her grandfather's actual grave is in Hickman, Kentucky. I think that this is also where her great uncle Jess Helm and great aunt Nell Helm were buried. Her paternal grandparents are buried in Nazareth, Pennsylvania.
